



**Stavros B. Thomadakis** is Emeritus Professor of financial economics at the University of Athens. A graduate of Yale University and the Sloan School of Management, M.I.T. He has held professorships at U.S. Universities.

He has published extensively on banking, finance, industrial economics, financial history and European issues. He has authored and co – edited five books, the most recent among them (in Greek) titled “State and Development: an Evolutionary Pairing”.

He has a long record of national and international public service. He served as first chairman of the Public Interest Oversight Board, overseeing international audit, ethical, and educational standard-setting for the accounting profession. He is former Chairman of the Capital Market Commission of Greece and the European Regional Committee of IOSCO.

He is chairman of the board of the University of the Aegean, a member of the Hellenic Council for Corporate Governance and a member of the ‘Stakeholders Group’ of the European Securities Markets Authority (ESMA).
