



Xenofon Avlonitis was born in Athens in 1969. He received a BA in Economic Studies from the University of Piraeus followed by a Post Graduate degree (MSc) in Business Finance from Brunel University, England. From 1988 to 1992 he worked in the financial department of “Fulgor S.A”. In 1995, he joined “Edrasis Ch. Psalidas S.A.” as treasurer and investor relations officer.
